On 18 and 19 of July 2019, was held the first kick-off meeting of the international project 'ICTeen' – Integration of Immigrant Adolescent Girls in the use of ICT. The objective of this project is to support and encourage the use of ICT from a gender perspective. Its target group is female migrant adolescents from countries outside of Europe.

This project has several innovative outputs, such as development of a European web portal with useful material, creation of a network at European level to support immigrant adolescents, creation of a website for the project that links to the European web portal, one training manual for workers in the field of youth, one document containing the best practices about this topic of the five countries that are part of this project and training fifteen workers in the field of youth on the use of digital technologies by adolescent women immigrants.
