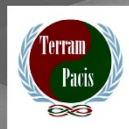




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“ICTeen – Integration of Immigrant Adolescent Girls in the use of ICT”

From 19th to 21st of November 2019 – Learning Activity (Zaragoza, Spain)

During three days we got together with the aim of raising awareness among workers in the youth field about initiatives related to digital culture, as well as those that can encourage young immigrants to interact in social networks. One of the aspects to discuss was the introduction of social inclusion as a necessary aspect of development for immigrant adolescents and train young workers to become effective leaders in their organizations and apply practices related to gender equality in the use of ICT.

The meeting gave the opportunity to three participants from each organisation to learn more about digital literacy, gender equality as an European value, non-sexist language and of course about our main topic - Integration of immigrant adolescents through ICT.
